Dear friends,

It gives me immense pleasure to present to you IVDP's Annual Report for the year 2021-22.

In the last year, our work focussed on reaching the unreached people (Irulars) throughout our working districts. In spite of this COVID pandemic situation, our programmes continued to reach out to women, especially from the marginalised communities in the poorest and remote rural areas, to make a positive impact in their lives and livelihoods.

TACKLING POVERTY THROUGH EMPOWERING WOMEN...

At present we are working with **15,355** SHGs to directly reach out around 2,74,353 women through SHG, health, education and livelihood programmes. Lasting change can only become a reality when underlying causes of poverty and social addressed exclusion are in a holistic manner. In this journey our SHGs loan portfolio has reached a new height of Rs. 1136.16 Crores. As a unique programme of IVDP, the SHG members have received Rs. 66 Crores as dividend during this year.

Last year the IVDP have spent **Rs. 26.43 Crores** for various philanthropic activities including Life Security Fund, in particular, we have spent **Rs. 3.72** Crores for COVID relief activities. To put together so far we have spent **Rs. 115.20** Crores as a humanitarian aid. Due to the continous interventions of IVDP, the women become breadwinners in their family, financially independent and empowered to make their own decisions.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank our board members, bankers, partners, staff, animators and well wishers for their strong and consistent support, without which we would not have been able to achieve so much, particularly when we needed to find solutions to big development challenges.






IVDP was founded in 1979 at Motragi Village, Natrampalayam in Thally block of Krishnagiri district in the midst of the thick forest.

While staying with the poor villagers Mr. Kulandai Francis realised the dare needs of the rural people in the locality. He felt that without health and education, development will not take place in the society.


In 1977,

Mr. Kulandai Francis started 20 night schools and first aid centres in and around Natrampalayam and Biligundu Villages in the erstwhile Dharmapuri District.

He travelled by coracle (Parisal) across the river Cauvery to reach the tribal children in the forest for organizing night school for them. He also arranged the fishing license from the Govt. for the fisherman in Biligundu village.



Natershed Projects



From 1979 to 2002, IVDP implemeted watershed programs around the hills of Anjetty Region. This involved with planning and construction of 92 major and 239 minor check dams, built across streams and gullies in the hilly region.

The check dams are designed to retain monsoon rains, leading to the increased groundwater levels and storing water for the irrigation, livestock and domestic requirements of the villagers.







Self Help Groups





When Mr. Kulandai Francis was constantly thinking of bringing transformation among the poor villagers, then we came out with a novel idea of forming groups for their development. At first, he started men SHG and it was not much successful as the members were so irregular and failed to repay their loans.

Then he shifted his focus towards women in 1985 and started Annai Velankanni SHG with 12 members in Sesurajapuram. This first group collected only 50 paise as indivual savings.

Now it grown as 15355 SHGs and spread over 4 District in Tamil Nadu.


IVDP Nethaji Matriculation School was started as a Tamil Medium School in the year 2001 and later it was converted into English Medium. Then it was upgraded as a Matriculation School in the year 2013. At present 514 students are studying from LKG to X std.





With the support of UNICEF Chennai, IVDP initiated the Child Friendly Village Planning Project during 2005-2007 in five blocks (139 panchayats) of Krishnagiri District to improve health, water, sanitation and education among women and children.

IVDP Skill Training Centre for Youth was started in 2008 at Hanumanthapuram Village, Dharmapuri dt. Through this centre the rural youth and dropout students of the remote rural areas are empowered with Computer and Communicative English skills.





The Newly built IVDP head office at Shanthi Nagar, Krishnagiri was inaugurated in 2012. It helps in planning and coordinating all the activities of IVDP SHGs in 4 Districts of Tamil Nadu.

Three decades of tireless pursuit have borne fruit. Mr. Kulandai Francis, Founder President received Ramon Magsaysay Award 2012 from Philippines Government.

The Magsaysay Foundation said that the Award was given to Mr. Kulandai Francis for "his visionary zeal, his profound faith in community energy, sustained programme in pursuit of the holistic economic empowerment of thousands of women and their families in rural India."







IVDP had identified and constructed 316 houses sizing 176 sq. ft. to the worst affected poor families in Cuddalore district during the flood due to "Vardha Cyclone" at the cost of Rs.1.56 Crores







In late July 2018, severe floods affected the state of Kerala due to unprecedented high rainfall during the monsoon season. After seeing the great sufferings of the people in neighbouring state of Kerala, the IVDP President made an appeal with its SHG members to contribute a small amount of Rs. 50/- each. Like "Little Drops of Water Make the Mighty Ocean" the IVDP have raised a huge amount of Rs. 1 Crore for flood relief.

On 15th October 2018, the IVDP President "Ramon Magsaysay" Mr. KULANDAI FRANCIS handed over the demand draft worth of Rs. 1 Crore with Hon'ble Chief Minister of Kerala, Mr. PINARAYI VIJAYAN at the State Secretariat, Thiruvanathapuram.





IVDP Women SHGs in 10 Blocks of Krishnagiri District Upto March 2022





The COVID-19 pandemic and the ensuing lockdown had adversely affected peoples' lives, particularly the marginalized sections of the populations with loss of livelihoods, food shortage and disruptions in access to health services and education.

In IVDP also many SHG members lost their husbands and close relatives. This trend suddenly pushed them into tough situation and collapsed their normal life. In order to save its members from the worst situation and console them, the IVDP has provided

a financial assistance of Rs. 50,000 each to its 370 Self Help Group Members who lost their husbands due to COVID 19 pandemic. Along with this relief amount, the IVDP President also provided the food materials each worth of Rs. 1025/- to all the 370 SHG members.

Further the IVDP provided the financial assistance of Rs. 1 lakh each for the children. who lost their mother (IVDP SHG member) and father due to COVID.

MAINSTREAMING IRULARS

Tamil Nadu constitutes one percent of total India's tribal population. One of the largest tribes in Tamil Nadu is Irular, they are Dravidian tribe found in the southern states. The word 'Irular' derived from Tamil word called "Irul" which means 'darkness', 'Irular' means those who are in darkness. Irulars speak Tamil dialect.

Earlier the Irula tribes were hunters and they have known for their special expertise in snake trapping. They earned their livelihood by catching the snake, rats, selling firewood, honey and its bee wax.

The socio-economic living conditions of Irular have been marked by poverty, illiteracy, ignorance and lack of social and economic security. They struggle hard for their bare necessities. Since most of them are illiterate they have not been able to come out of pathetic living conditions. Overall the living conditions of Irulars are unstable and pitiable.



Special Project for IRULARS



The Irulars are living in large numbers at Krishnagiri, Dharmapuri and Tirupattur districts, mostly in isolated, hidden areas and outskirts without any basic amenities. By realizing the pathetic situation of Irular communities during this pandemic period, the IVDP President took this as a flagship programme of IVDP for the next few years and planned to reach them personally with the help of IVDP SHGs spreading every nook and corner of these districts. Finally he launched the programme and personally went all the 212 habitations and distributed the relief materials to 5.529 beneficiaries which belong to Irular community.

Loans

The credit/loan facilities given to the poor rural women by the financial institutions are bringing significant changes in their lives. The quantum of the loan is fixed, depends on the saving corpus of the group.

Invariably the SHG members require financial support for all their developmental activities. Irrespective of their livelihood jobs, every member avails either one or more loans and make use of the money for their developmental activities like small business, agricultural, house construction, educational expenses, marriage expenses, debt swapping, etc.

The IVDP is committed to bring about women empowerment through women SHGs by means of facilitating various loans at a reasonable rate of interest.

Types of loans availed by IVDP SHG members:

- 1. Sangha loan (from the savings) at the reasonable interest rate fixed by the groups.
- 2. Sangha Special Loan
- 3. IVDP loan
- 4. Bank loan: Here the bank loans are sanctioned only to the group accounts. Naturally all members become equally responsible for the loan amount sanctioned. If a member fails to repay the loan, all other remaining members should take the responsibility of repayment.

Apart from the Sangha loans, the groups have easy access to get IVDP loan and bank loan.

Money lending with huge interest rate exploits poor people in the villages. But IVDP offers the loans to its SHG members with same rate of interest which commercial bank offers for its loans. Further the commercial banks are offering exclusive low rate of interest for IVDP SHG loans alone.

The IVDP SHGs in Dharmapuri and Vellore districts avails the loans from banks at a concessional rate under NRLM Project norms. According to that, the SHGs are getting loans with the 3% interest subvention and 4% additional subsidy per annum for the loans up to Rs. 3 lakhs. This reduces their interest burden further.

In IVDP, the audit will assess the quality of recording of books of accounts by SHGs, verify individual pass books of SHG members, reconciliation of bank passbook and SHG books of account, assist the members to ensure that the federated SHGs and its members have utilized the credit in the manner and purpose, infuses confidence among the bankers that the SHGs are being properly monitored and regularly verified by the SHG federation and come out with training needs of the SHG, which has been audited.

Audit Ensures

- Regular cash transaction misappropriations if any are found out and suitable action is taken to solve the problems.
- Wrong entries, missing entries, in income and expenditure / transaction are found out and suitable action is taken.
- Audit enables and qualifies the SHGs to avail various loans.
- Audit helps the groups to stabilise or establish their sound financial position.
- Grading the SHGs and animators, based on the performance in credit linkage activities.

Consolidating the income, expenditure and accounting of financial transactions of the SHGs for a particular period of time (April to March) are audited by a group of IVDP staff.

Kinds of Audit

- 1. Internal Audit
- 2. External Audit
- 3. Group Grading
- 4. Animators Grading

Internal audit and it's special features

The accounts of SHGs belonging to cluster level federation are verified by the full time field supervisors of another CLF.

Internal Audit will be conducted once in every three months. All the records in connection with the group transactions and bank statements will be verified in the audit. The auditing will also instruct the groups to clear their dues in the bank if any.

External audit and its special features

A group of experts in the IVDP head office under the able guidance and supervision of an external auditor verifies income, expenditure and all transactions of the groups at the end of every financial year and gives grading to groups. Producing bank statement, getting no dues certificate from the bank, evaluation and grading, rectification of the errors and arrive a detailed balance sheet are the special features of the external audit. First the team will audit the groups manually then it will be cross checked with the entries in software.

Finally the audit statement will be prepared and sent to chartered accountant for his final approval.




Empowering Women Through Technology

Women are more precious in God's creature. When the family suddenly lost its back borne, the entire family upsets very much. In this grave situation the IVDP and its members not only share their condolences and feelings, but also support their families with reasonable contributions. This is how the IVDP SHG members reflect their joint responsibility in their groups.



The Life Security Fund is given to the nominees of the deceased members every year.



During the year 2021

Rs. 9.36 Crores

have been distributed to the

1,702 nominees

(each Rs. 50,000/-)

of deceased

IVDP SHG members as a

Life Security Fund.

Rs. 5,000/- is given immediately for the funeral expenses to the family from the Group General Fund.

From the beginning of the scheme Rs. 47.36 crores have been distributed to 9603 nominees of the deceased.

What is Life Security Fund?

SHG members share their feelings of cooperation and solidarity towards the family members of the deceased.

At the time of joining, a member has to contribute Rs. 100 as a entry fee for LSF. The total collection of this amount is kept as a fixed deposit in the name of IVDP LSF.

Every year the amount disbursed as LSF will be equally contributed by all the SHG members who have enrolled in the IVDP-LSF scheme.

Life Security Fund is created to support the family even after the demise of the member.

This is a different form of life insurance.

A lump sum is given to the nominee of the deceased and to the member who becomes permanently disabled in an accident.

This scheme is in existence since 2001.

This scheme is applicable only for IVDP-SHG members.

The new members subscription is credited first in their respective SHG accounts and then transferred to IVDP-SHG monitoring fund Account.

Every year from January to December a list of the deceased members and permanently disabled after accident are prepared and relief fund is given.

Special features of the scheme

Rs. 50,000 is given for the normal deaths.

Rs. 25,000 is given for the permanent disability in accident.

It increases the credibility of the groups in the bank for availing loans.

Conditions for receiving LSF

Death Certificate has to be produced.

Natural and accident deaths will be covered under the scheme.

Suicidal death is not eligible.

A member who has left the group is not entitled for LSF even if she has paid the LSF subscription. (At the time of death she must be a member in IVDP-SHG)

Only the nominee mentioned by the deceased group members are eligible for receiving LSF.

Resolution Group connection has to be submitted to the respective cluster level federation.

Loan balance if any in the name of the deceased, will be deducted from the LSF and the balance amount will be disbursed.







Social Work Needs Continuity and Life-Time Commitment

Reflections of Rev. Fr. Agilan Sarprasadam SDB, Provincial – Salesian Province of Tiruchy,

I am inspired by Mr. Kulandai Francis, the Founder and President of IVDP (Integrated Village Development Project) Krishnagiri, for his contribution towards empowerment of women in our times. All of us are aware of his benevolence and generosity during the 12th National Boscoree held in our province at Thanjavur, and his continued support to the social reach-out activities at Don Bosco Youth Village, Keeranur. He has promised to take interest in all the other developmental works of our province as well, and I am sure, he will be one of our great benefactors and supporters in the years to come. Being an ex-seminarian, he shared his life experiences with us in various forums like the provincial council etc. I had the privilege of meeting him a few times and I am grateful to God for such a unique personality, who has gone through struggles and crisis in life. But today he has given life to lakhs of women and their families. I am presenting to you his life story.

Mr. Francis had faced great financial difficulties to pursue his higher education. There was little wealth in his family, so funding even the most basic education for Mr. Francis was a struggle. His parents, however, understood the importance of education, so sacrificed the small piece of land (considered to be the family's only property) to enable him to graduate from Annamalai University. Amidst all difficulties, He continued to educate himself, completed a Social Development Course at Coady International Institute, Canada, and a Rural Management Course in the Philippines. As Mr. Francis, personally experienced poverty at an early age

itself, he started IVDP to help the poor and needy, to overcome all their financial struggles and burdens. This early impact of his parents' immense sacrifice stimulated him to dedicate his life towards helping the poor. Following his stint with the Fathers of Holy Cross in 1970; involvement in relief work with Caritas India during Bangladeshi war; participation in relief works during the drought in Pune in 1972, were the down to earth learnings further enriched and streamlined the direction and focus in life.

From the learning of the worst times of his life, had brought to the fore his exceptional insight to assertively plan and build SHGs (Self Help Groups) for rural women. He planned SHGs as a mighty micro economic weapon to take on the unquestionable coercive feudal money lending system that usurped the hard-earned money of the villagers, outdoing the officially established rural lending institutions.

Today, IVDP SHGs are the outstanding example of a viable, effective rural credit mechanism par excellence in the country, given the present economic, socio political environment in India. Some of the salient features are the following. IVDP is basically a non-profit NGO, striving women empowerment towards holistic approach through SHGs, since 1979. IVDP also believes in women development possible through their economic initiatives. It's self-reliance and economic independence liberates them from the clutches of poverty and the total control by men in the family and society. Till date IVDP had promoted 14,840 Self Help Groups with a membership of 2,67,120 women. The SHGs spread over Krishnagiri, Dharmapuri, Vellore and Tirupattur districts of Tamil Nadu. The SHGs have transacted more than Rs.9101.28 Crores, since 1989. "If I can, why not you? (a great congregation and the province)," is the challenge he proposed to me. And I was thinking about it for a very long time. I guess the time is ripe to take up this challenge and such proposals by us confreres of Tiruchy Province.

Joyful greetings from Fr. B. Francis Xavier msfs!

When I see you, I am reminded of my boyhood. I knew you to be a lively and gentle person living in the house next to the old church in my native village Sesurajapuram. Your appearance is still very fresh in my memory; with thick curled hair, well built physique and with bell pants outfit. If I am right,



you used to distribute medicines. And later, you took a completely new Avatar by forming the IVDP to help the poor and needy of all creed, casts and color.

I was then still studying in boarding schools in settipatti later in Kovilur and in Salem. The insufficient and poor quality meals provided in boardings those days made my life even more difficult. My village had only muddy roads. There were irregular bus services (2 times a day). After each holiday, returning to school those days was a himalayan task as all the school going students of Sesurajapuram studying in different schools had to catch up the same bus. We could hardly breath-in; because the bus used to be completely full and there was hardly any place to keep both the legs down.

These difficulties made me long for good roads, transport facilities and above all, a good school with a hostel facility in my village. Along with these dreams, your ministry was a stamp-mark in my mind to this day. Yes, dear Bro. Francis, you have always been the role model and inspiration to me.

These a few projects that God enabled me to do for the students of my village (Sesurajapuram, Natrampalayam) are inspired by you. I thank you for the person that you are. As far as I am aware, your ministry covers 4 district of Tamil Nadu. May God continue to bless in your ministry for the poor and needy.

I wish you, your team and all the well wishers of IVDP all the best and God's blessings.

May God continue to bless you to carry on this noble task for the many more years to come.


